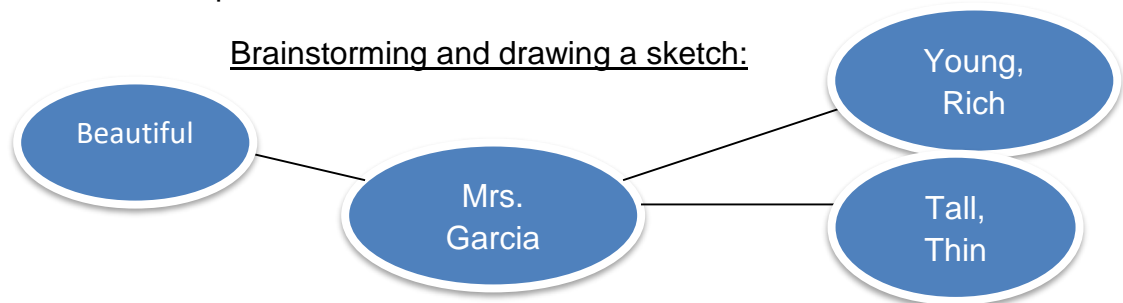

Gathering Ideas - Depending on your topic you can collect ideas and make notes, there is a few different ways of doing that.

Example:

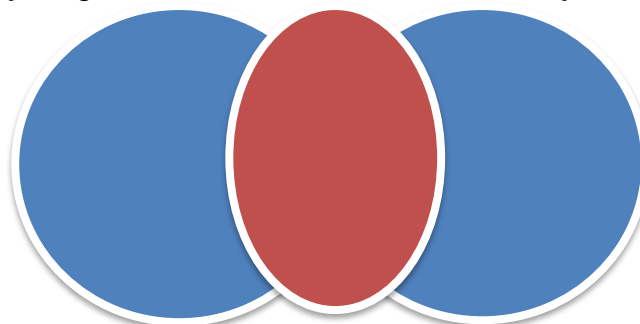
- 1) Brainstorming- an idea that someone thinks of suddenly
- 2) Drawing a sketch- a brief or hasty outline of facts, occurrences, etc.
- 3) Free write- is a prewriting technique in which a person writes continuously for a set period of time without regard to spelling, grammar, or topic.
- 4) Venn diagram- a diagram that uses circles to represent sets and their relationships.
- 5) Clustering- The clustering approach often reveals new and unexpected connections between ideas and allows you to see different themes and categories of thought.

Examples of the most important:



Free writing: *Mrs. Garcia is very beautiful young lady. She is a rich person she can buy everything she likes and desires. She is very tall and thin.*

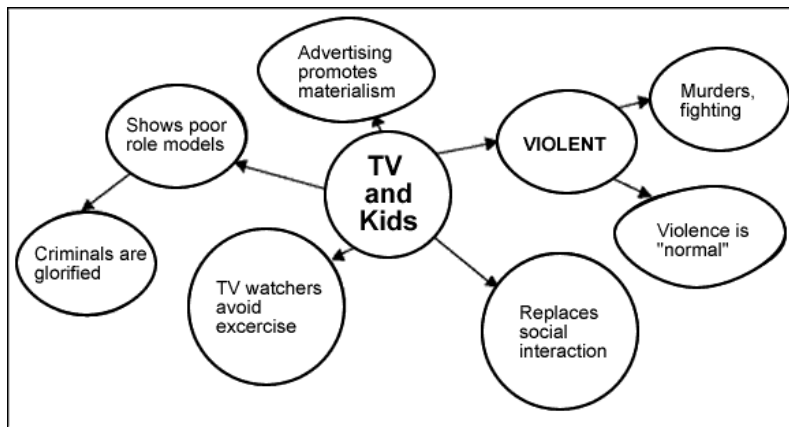
Venn diagram:
